



A monumental undertaking of Carl Flesch's work for teachers and students. The range of material covered by this massive book is enormous: Body Posture, The Left Arm (positions & fingerings), Vibrato, Bowing (including all varieties of strokes), Tone Production, Musical Memory, etc., musical examples, and covers experts from the works of all the master composers, hand diagrams and a table for the consistent use of bowing and fingering symbols

Armenian teachers know the work by Carl Flesch. It was published in Russian during the USSR period. We want to produce the Armenian edition in partnership with Berlin publisher Ries & Erler.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?:

- No less than 1500 pupils study violin every year, and several hundreds of teachers guide them
- Teachers and students need a source of guidance in their native language


