1. Our Mission & People

The Primavera Foundation Armenia was co-founded by Anastasia Budanoque and Elena Yakovleva in September 2022.

Our mission is to help Armenia resonate worldwide by building cultural bridges between Armenia and other nations, supporting young Armenian musicians, developing educational activities and artistic infrastructure, and celebrating Armenian cultural heritage internationally by organizing events. It is our goal for the rich culture and musical tradition of Armenia to be seen and heard all around the globe, represented by its talented artists and producers.

The Foundation launch was officially announced on November 17, 2022, with a historic concert at the Aram Khachaturian Hall: pianist Mikhail Pletnev performed with the National Philharmonic Orchestra of Armenia under the baton of the legendary maestro Vladimir Fedoseyev.

In 2024, the Foundation team organized a total of 34 events and performances, including lectures, Q&A sessions, and round tables, and conducted 66 master classes. Additionally, we presented the three-day Visages d'Armenie festival in France.

We continued our collaboration with Armenian Musicians — pianist Ruben Kozin, classical guitarists Vahan Sargsyan and Henrik Melikyan, who traveled to Syunik and Tavush with free performances in solidarity with Artsakh displaced people. Our goal was to bring emotional relief and support to the local communities. The artists gave performances and master classes in a total of seven villages and towns.

Other highlights included two classical music performances in Yerevan, three concerts in France as part of the Visages d'Armenie Festival, and special projects in Armenia (detailed in Clause 3 of this Report). We also produced thirteen classical music concerts in Armenian regions with free entrance and 45 in-person master classes for young musicians in various regions of Armenia.

The events organized by the Foundation independently and in partnership with Armenian cultural institutions attracted over 2000 people in total.

During this period, the Foundation worked with distinguished experts and artists, including conductor Vasily Petrenko, Chairman of the Artistic Council of the Foundation (UK/Russia), violinist Maximilian Simon (Germany), Professor Irina Krasotina (Russia), classical guitarists Nikita Nedelko (Russia) and Valeria Galimova (Germany), as well as Armenian classical guitarists Vahan Sargsyan and Henrik Melikyan, pianist Ruben Kozin (Armenia) and pianist Philipp Kopachevsky (Russia).

Together with our experts and partners, we traveled from Yerevan to Syunik, visiting the town of Kapan and surrounding villages, and the Tavush province, where we visited the towns of Ijevan, Dilijan, and Noyemberian. We went to Gyumri in Shirak, and to Hrazdan in Kotayk. We flew from Yerevan to Paris and drove over 500 km to La Rochefoucauld-en-Angoumois.

2.2 Takeaways of the Year

Overall, 2024 was marked by significant forward strides in the team's professional development, audience engagement, and international recognition. The Foundation is committed to expanding its reach, leveraging technology to increase accessibility, and strengthening Armenia's global presence through culture.

A. ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

- International exposure. Maestro
 Vasily Petrenko's Academy for
 Conductors puts Armenia in the
 spotlight of international media
 and the global community. By
 contrast, the Visages d'Armenie
 festival in France allows the
 audience to discover Armenia
 without visiting the country. The
 collaboration with the Prima
 Classic record label (USA/Spain)
 gives Armenian musicians a
 global stage for their art, with
 access to all major streaming
 platforms.
- Shift from standalone master classes to large-scale initiatives. We have decreased the number of musical master classes we organize, while at the same time prioritizing multifaceted projects like the Chamber Music School, an annual educational initiative that comprises individual and ensemble master classes, as well as stage performance training and we have focused our attention on the translation of teaching manuals and production of publications in Armenian.
- Support for Armenia's regions.
 The Armenian Musicians for
 Armenian Communities project,
 launched in 2023, focuses on
 organizing free performances
 for remote towns and villages in
 Armenian marzes while providing
 performance opportunities
 for emerging Armenian artists
 identified by our experts through
 other Foundation initiatives.

B. OUR APPROACH

- The Foundation's approach has evolved from one-time artist visits to Armenia to larger-scale initiatives lasting from three to five years. These include the internationally recognized projects of Maestro Vasily Petrenko's Academy for Conductors, the Visages d'Arménie Festival, and the Yerevan Chamber Music School.
- To ensure our educational efforts can continue uninterrupted, we have drafted the first version of a system to track the efforts and progress of our fellows and external students. The Fellowship Program is set to launch in 2025.
- After relying primarily on private donations for its first two years, the Foundation has now expanded into professional partnership projects and plans to fund grants and raise funds throughout 2025. We are therefore more vulnerable and more dependent on Armenian businesses and institutions that support culture, as well as the political agenda.
- We have focused more resources and effort on infrastructure initiatives: either by supporting Armenian teachers by providing them with teaching books (or toolkits) in Armenian on the violin and chamber ensemble performance, and video materials to support their everyday work, as well as supporting Armenian artists by publishing master classes, career advice, and other videos on the Foundation's YouTube channel.

2.3 Projects in Focus

a) Music For Emotional Relief & Support Program

Based on the feedback from both artists and audiences, we believe this program has resulted in the following mutual benefits:

- Armenian young musicians got an opportunity to have additional performance experience in front of an audience (which is essential for professional artistic development and growth).
- The specially designed "easy" program enabled members of local communities to enjoy performances by professionally trained artists.

b) Classical Guitar Program

The first national Classical Guitar Competition helped us identify both emerging Armenian classical guitar talents as well as their teachers. We also formalized the processes, procedures, and politics for organizing competitions for further projects on various instruments.







c) Chamber Music Program by Professor Irina Krasotina

We finalized the design and structure of the Chamber Music educational program, which now comprises the following key activities:

- An annual (at least) week-long Chamber Music School in Yerevan, as a final stage of at least two in-person visits of Professor Krasotina to Armenia during each Academic year;
- A specially designed seminar for chamber music teachers to facilitate the exchange of professional experience and expertise;
- Publication of methodical materials for chamber music teachers, translated into Armenian (included in the Foundation's 2024/25 Project Map);
- An ensemble is an invaluable tool for fostering stage collaborations and communication, building mutual trust and understanding as well as creating additional social connections and friendships. We believe in the importance of developing the Chamber Ensemble Program in both Yerevan and all across Armenia.

- Filming and post-production of video lessons by Professor Krasotina (with Armenian subtitles) aimed at supporting Armenian teachers at middle and higher educational levels;
- Release of Chamber Ensemble repertoire recommendations for teachers organized by age and the level of ensemble members.







Ensemble music plays a vital role in an artist's development: it provides a safe and collaborative space for musicians to enhance their skills, explore chamber repertoire for future collaborations, and prepare for a potential career as a chamber musician.

d) Academy for Conductors by Maestro Vasily Petrenko

The first Academy by Maestro Vasily Petrenko, which was organized in partnership with the Armenian National Philharmonic Orchestra, produced the following results:



- The event put Armenia on the radar of international media and professionals in the global classical music community. This high-profile cultural event, which could be organized in any cultural capital of Europe, made Armenia resonate across the globe.
- Applications were received from 15 countries, and four out of the five active participants of the Academy would have never otherwise visited Armenia in any foreseeable future. These four young conductors flew from Mexico, Norway, China, and Russia. The Foundation organized a sightseeing tour for them, which contributed to the fact that they left Armenia as the country's cultural ambassadors.
- Thanks to the extensive media coverage of the event in Armenia, the profession of the conductor (and classical musicians in general) was put in the spotlight, which undoubtedly benefits future generations of young conductors and musicians;
- The Academy's closing gala concert at the Aram Khachaturian Concert Hall was open to the public free of charge, allowing everyone to enjoy a one-hour classical music performance. The program featured well-known works by Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, and Stravinsky, making it accessible even for those who do not frequently attend classical music events.



f) Infrastructure Projects and Initiatives

To support violin teachers and students, we negotiated and signed an agreement to publish 500 copies of Carl Flesch's book The Art of Violin Playing in Armenian, as well as a methodological textbook for chamber ensemble teachers. Both projects are included in the Foundation's 2024/25 Project Map.

2.4 What They Say

At the end of each event or project, we always distribute feedback forms among the participants. This compulsory practice helps us maintain constructive and effective bilateral communication with our fellows and their teachers. Additionally, it is a way for us to identify activities to prioritize and areas of our work that need improvement.

We carefully review the feedback that we receive. For example, we will be searching for financial support opportunities to organize additional educational activities on artistic career development since this area was prioritized by our participants (as shown below). At the same time, the Chamber Ensemble program has already been included in the Foundation's 2024/25 Project Map as yet another priority.



We aim to establish our YouTube channel as Armenia's free and globally accessible resource. We strive to provide artistic support and guidance to young Armenian musicians and their teachers by offering artistic master classes on piano, violin, chamber ensemble, cello, and classical guitar. We also use it to provide career advice and publish insightful videos from musicians with established careers and long professional experience, feature performances by the Foundation's fellows and participants of our Educational Academy events, as well as share media reportages about our activities and interviews with our team members.

This is why we regularly film our major educational activities and produce videos. In 2024, our video production team added 131 videos (including shorts). Those new videos include:



b) Special Project with Amaryan Charitable Foundation

The project's goal is to produce a series of video lessons entitled Psychophysiology For Musicians by classical guitarist and laureate of international competitions Valeria Galimova (Russia/Germany) and make them available on the Foundation's YouTube channel with Armenian subtitles.

These video lessons aim to inform musicians about the importance of maintaining the physical health of the body's muscular system. Their content is based on modern European theoretical developments and specially selected practical exercises.

"Over 80% of musicians suffer from pain. At best, it can be managed to some extent. If not treated, it leads to premature retirement. Learn these simple exercises to prevent excessive strain and hand injuries, to continuously enjoy performing, and to maintain a proficient and healthy playing technique. As musicians, we play our musical instruments using our entire body, and it is, therefore, important to be aware of musical psychophysiology at any age and any level." – Valeria Galimova, classical guitarist, the course author
